JUVENILE MEMBERSHIP

With effect from 1 March 2011, there will be created a new category of membership called "Juvenile Membership".

Membership of this category shall be subject to the following conditions:

- (a) The number of Juvenile members shall not exceed 20.
- (b) This Category will only be open to sons/daughters and grandchildren of playing members of the Club.
- (c) Admission shall be laid down by Rule 6 and subject to the requirement that the applicant for Membership must be at least 8 years and not older than 11 years of age.
- (d) Members of the Juvenile Section who have a place on the Junior Waiting List shall have no preference on that Waiting List other than that set out in Rule 36(c).
- (e) The Annual Subscription and playing restrictions will be set by Committee. All money received from Annual Subscriptions paid by Juvenile members shall be invested in the development of junior golf at the Club.
- (f) Play will only be allowed on the Hillhouse Course and Practice Ground in accordance with the playing restrictions set out by Committee in (e) above.
(Times of play – after 7pm Monday to Friday and after 3pm on Sunday)
- (g) Juvenile Members must be accompanied by an adult member at all times on the Golf Course and in the Clubhouse.
- (h) Membership of the Juvenile Section shall cease and shall not be renewable at the AGM following the attainment of the Member's 11th birthday.
- (i) Juvenile members shall have neither right nor interest in the property of the Club and shall not be entitled to vote at any meetings of the Club nor to join in the Club competitions other than those specified by Committee. They shall not be entitled to introduce visitors and may have their privileges summarily suspended or withdrawn by Committee without the necessity of the Committee being obliged to give reasons therefore.
