The Council and Committee recognise that fashion trends and a wide variety of age groups within our membership can lead to a difference of opinion on what determines acceptable dress standards. Kilmarnock Barassie GC fosters a relaxed, family friendly atmosphere whilst maintaining a high standard of dress, both on and off the course.

The use of smart phones/ mobile devices is acceptable provided they are on silent and calls taken in the hall or front porch. VAPING is not permitted anywhere in the Clubhouse.

Changing of shoes or apparel in the car park is not acceptable.

On the Course

Acceptable	Not Acceptable
Shirts must be appropriate golf attire.	T-shirts, vests, rugby/ football shirts, track suits or hoodies.
Trousers can be long, ¾ length or short. Shorts must be around knee length and tailored.	Beach or draw string shorts, cargo pocket trousers or jeans.
Golf shoes.	Trainers, hiking boots.

Off the Course/ in the Clubhouse

Acceptable	Not Acceptable
Golf attire, provided clean and dry.	Obvious work clothes.
Smart denim jeans.	Frayed or ripped jeans.
Tailored knee length shorts.	Other sports attire ie. football/ rugby.
Smart casual wear.	Any form of beach wear, track suits or shell suits or collarless T-shirts. Hats must be removed.
Clean and smart footwear.	No metal spikes.

Members should make sure that their guests follow the rules of the club

We understand there will be cases open to interpretation but hope the tone and dignity of the club will be respected at all times.

If a member feels that dress or behaviour of someone in the club does not meet the listed standards, then they can report it to the bar staff, who in turn can make a note of issue and report to office staff. There is no intent that a member or guest will be approached directly to avoid confrontation or embarrassment

In the event of any dispute the management's / staff's decision will be final.
